What Do Language teachers think about?

Language teachers work with many types of learners in a wide variety of settings Some teachers work with learners who are surrounded by the language they are trying to learn (this is called a second language setting), while others teach a language that is only spoken by a distant community (a foreign language setting)

Language and culture in foreign language teaching

Both of language and culture have a function of communication because they both carry meanings On the one hand, language carries syntactic, semantic and pragmatic meanings for language users to communicate (Brooks, 1997) On the other hand, culture carries meanings and cultural meanings are expressed through patterns of behaviour, eg, language
