Strokes in Children with Sickle Cell Disease

• If your child has a stroke, there is a 70 percent chance of having another stroke unless blood transfusions are given every month • If your child has a stroke, a blood transfusion will be needed every month to help prevent future strokes damaged part of the brain as seen on an MRI
